PART 2 - DUTIES

a. POST CONTEXT:

General: The ISAF CJPOTF is the sole asset of COMISAF to directly communicate to the local population via organic mass media. It forms the centrepiece of the ISAF information effort towards the population within the ISAF AOO's. The CJPOTF's task is to influence and to inform specific target audiences approved by the NAC and explains COMISAF's mission and activities to a broad public. Thereby, it creates a supportive atmosphere for the conduct of military operations under the ISAF mandate. The CJPOTF is directly subordinated to COMISAF.

Specific: Chief MIFA will be responsible to provide monitoring and analysis of the Target Audience (TA) and the TA media so as to allow Chief PSYOPS Theatre TAA/TES Section and Commander CJPOTF to better execute their mission.

b. REPORTS TO: CHIEF PSYOPS THEATRE TAA/TE SECTION

c. PRINCIPAL DUTIES.

- Develop and maintain a concept for multiple source intelligence M&A related to changing operational requirements.
- 2. Develop and maintain a concept for countering and/or preventing adverse effects to ISAF mission and/or ISAF PSYOPS objectives arising from external multiple source media, including enemy propaganda.
- 3. Gather intelligence from multiple sources concerning local/international media of varying types and different aspects of the TA life and culture.
- 4. Provide executive summaries and in-depth analysis and assessments of MM, Hostile Propaganda, PSYOPS products, etc. to CJPOTF and HQ ISAF.

- 5. Provide critical assessments of any related OSINT or other Intelligence related to Media and PSYOPS activities to stakeholders.
- 6. Provide critical recommendations based analysis to said stakeholders.
- 7. Act as advisor and consultant to related PSYOPS efforts within CJPOTF.
- 8. Plan and coordinate daily/weekly MM and analysis from multiple local and international radio, television, print, and other Open Source Intelligence (OSINT) and related Intelligence sources.
- 9. Conduct briefings and seminars, as required, and engage in roundtable discussions, "brainstorming" sessions, "murder boards" and other ISAF PSYOPS related topics and activities and act as expert advisor/consultant during said sessions.
- 10. Conduct research into topics related to incoming or outgoing ISAF portieres and PSYOPS from multiple sources including, but not limited to, Unclassified Internet, Classified Intelligence databases such as JOIIS< LOCE, etc. and such other sources as may be accessed.
- 11. By order create, draft, supervise and, if and when necessary, edit/proofread, summaries, briefings, RFI's, FRAGO's and other documents pertaining to monitoring and analysis of related media and recommendations to CJPOT and ISAF Command.
- 12. By order plan and assist with counterpropaganda efforts using ISAF media and other PSYOPS products and capabilities.
- 13. Participate in meetings as ordered in ISAF AOO and NATO sphere.
- 14. Establish and maintain working relationships with pertinent local and international media, government, military, diplomatic, intelligence and other related entities, organisations and individuals.
- 15. Conduct and participate in pre-test and post-test, polls, information gathering, face-to-face (F2F) communications with TA and other related stakeholders.
- 16. Establish and maintain contacts/relationships with the TA and maintain knowledge of local customs, beliefs, political, security, social structure and all other necessary knowledge so as to continue to provide expert advice to command and stakeholders regarding both ISAF and local/international media products and effect.
- 17. Supervise International Civilian Consultants and Local Civilian Personnel in the TAA/TES Section.
- 18. Assist with other analytical/assessments requirements within CJPOTF.

d. ADDITIONAL DUTIES

1. The incumbent may be required to perform such other related duties as may be directed. If needed, the personnel will be deployed within all ISAF Area of Operations.

- Minimum of seven years of professional analytical experience in a supervisory or managerial capacity in a establishment such as Media, Law Enforcement, Military Diplomatic or other governmental organisation.

- Experience in conduction of in-depth research from numerous multiple source.
- Experience in speaking publicly, engaging in open professional discussions, brainstorming sessions, roundtable discussions, seminars, briefings, VTCs and/or other related exchanges of ideas and recommendations.

- Undergraduate University degree in/or, but not limited to, Law, Science, IR, Psychology, Marketing/Advertising, Mass Media or other discipline related to the analysis of Media, Intelligence and/or PSYOPS.

b. Managerial Responsibilities.
